























## Avia C-10.8 (S-99.8), OK-BYH, Police Air Patrol Unit, Czechoslovak Police Air Force, Brno – Slatina, 1947 - 1950

This aircraft, assigned to the Police Air Patrol Unit, first flew in November 1946 and was then transferred to the LVU (Aviation Research Centre). There, it would serve until April 1947, when it was finally delivered to the Police Air Patrol Unit. It was camouflaged on the upper and side surfaces in a metal grey colour while the lower surfaces were painted in a darker grey. Aircraft that served with the Police Air Patrol Unit had their engine cowls, leading edges of the wings, the elevators and stabilizers painted wine red. The codes on the fuselage sides and upper and lower wing surfaces were in the same colour, outlined in white. Also common to the Police Air Patrol Unit aircraft were the triangular roundels.




## Avia C-10.6, EV-11, Command Flight, 2nd Air Division, Fighter Training Centre, Czechoslovak Air Force, Planá Air Base, České Budějovice, Spring 1947

This aircraft, borrowed from the Czechoslovak Police Air Foirce, flew with the black fuselage code EV-11 with the Air Force. The same code should also appear under the wings, according to Staff Command Order from January 1946. This, however, remains unconfirmed due to the low quality of photographic evidence. According to some sources, the entire aircraft was painted in a grey-green colour, most likely German RLM 02, with the white outlined Czechoslovak national roundels in six positions.




# C Avia C-10.21, OK-BYU, Police Air Patrol Unit, Czechoslovak Police Air Force, Prague – Ruzyně, 1947

This aircraft was the last to be assembled in the spring of 1947 by Avia at Letňany, after verification flights, it was transferred to the Police Air Patrol Unit element of the Czechoslovak Police Air Force in mid-July 1947 at Ruzyně in Prague, where it served until at least 1949. This aircraft was marked the same way as OK-BYH, with the exception of lacking the white border to the markings on the vertical tail surfaces.



## Avia C-10, EV-14, Fighter Training Centre, Czechoslovak Air Force, Planá Air Base, České Budějovice, 1947

The Fighter Training Centre, under the command of the 2nd Aviation Division, was established on February 1st, 1947, and its task was to ensure combat training for fighter pilots that passed through the Flight School. At first, the S-89 was used (Spitfire LF Mk.IXe), and in 1947 training was conducted on borrowed Avia C-10/S-99 aircraft, with the S-199 being used from April 1948. The Avia C-10/S-99 coded EV-14 served with the Army Air Force after deploying with the Police Air Patrol Unit, Czechoslovak Police Air Force. This is indicated not only by the wine red areas that adorned aircraft of this unit, but also the oversprayed original markings on the fuselage sides and both upper and lower surfaces of the wings. The aircraft was painted on the upper and side surfaces in a metal grey colour and on the lower surfaces in a darker grey.
