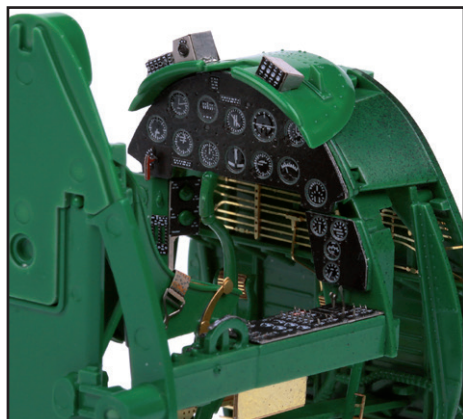


# EDITORIAL

My Friends, with this newsletter we will open a window allowing a glimpse into the upcoming year that we have just entered. It's not so slow entry how it was expected before Christmas, because all the necessary inventories were finished in last week of December, so we open our e-shop as well as our sales department today starting the shipping of the parcels already tomorrow. This situation just confirms the well known fact that the situation on the battlefield is ever changing, there may be some variations to the things you thought you already knew that may be news to you.

After the limited edition kits prepared for 2018, introduced in December Info, now let me introduce the other prepared project, new kits as well as various improvements in our aftermarket production, expected for this year. It is a basically straight forward affair to describe the developments and concepts that pertain to accessories. At first glance, they may appear to be insignificant changes, but they do have the potential of long lasting implications on production. For example, January sees the start of our masks being produced to not only cover the exterior surfaces of clear parts, but the interior ones as well. These dual surface sets will be suffixed TFace (T' for Two) as an easy identifier. Because we are really not as certain as internet forums would suggest as to their potential popularity, we will also be releasing each set in the classic outside surface only style as well. The TFace masks will begin their production run only with the bigger scales, 1/32nd and 1/48th, and will be limited to types that would suggest the highest demand. Their price point should be somewhere around 1.5 times the usual classic sets.

All of the photoetching will now be printed on new equipment, the advantages of which were already made clear last fall, during Novemberfest and even with some new items that were released during the final quarter of last year. The new machinery has better fidelity of detail and picks

out surface detail better, gives a significantly reduced raster effect and better prints over relief detail. This is a capability that is also leading us to experiment with this technology on resin parts, specifically on resin instrument panels. This would be particularly useful in connection with the lensed over instrument dials which will quickly become the norm for photoetching in 1/48th and 1/32nd scales not only for the straight PE lines, but the Brassin as well. Our intention with the painted resin is to eventually create a new line of products around it. We will discuss this in greater detail when it comes time to initiate actual production. Besides the lensed instruments becoming a standard item, so will weathered seat belts. These effects will be most noticeable and appreciated in 1/48th and 1/32nd scales. I won't go into specific details regarding accessory releases for the coming year, if only for the fact that my own view into the future is not perfect. I also have no crystal ball into what other companies are planning and that would have an impact.

The production of our own model kits is quite well defined and a closer look, however, will probably not bring about any major revelations. The first half of the year will see another two 1/48th scale Fw 190As, the first being the A-5 in March and the A-3 in June. In both cases, these depict the lighter version of the fighter with two wing cannon. It should be noted that neither the A-3 nor the A-5 have yet been released in this configuration by any company save for our December released A-3 in the Royal Class boxing. Over the second half of the year, this will be followed by one more boxing of the Fw 190A, but which version this will be is not yet certain, and it is also not out of the question that the Fw 190A-8 will be used for another Royal Class edition of the model. And while on the topic of the Fw 190A, I was originally very skeptical with respect to the A-2, but today I am in full acceptance and willing to consider its release as a stand alone ProfiPACK kit.

In May, we will be releasing the 1/72nd scale MiG-21MF Interceptor. These were aircraft produced by factory No. 21 in Gorky (Nizhny Novgorod nowadays). This kit will however contain a mix of international markings, not just those of Czechoslovakia. This will be reserved for a Limited Edition boxing



mirroring the MF kit released in 2016 in 1/48th scale. This will be followed by a Royal Class edition in the summer covering all MF production blocks, and in the fall by a MiG-21MF Fighter-Bomber ProfiPACK kit from factory No. 30 in Moscow.

This year will also see further releases of the Bf 109G and F. Besides taking advantage of already released versions in the Limited Edition kits, mentioned in the December newsletter, and Weekend Edition releases, we will see the Bf 109G-10 through the summer. This will be a version that will certainly garner a lot of attention and discussion, more than the others besides the first G-6 and F-4, since it is not simply a markings option kit, and utilized a lot of components of previous Gustav and Friedrich variants.

In the last newsletter I mentioned that we will be releasing the He 280. Similarly, we will be giving the Fokker D.VIII, also in 1/48th, the same treatment. That's how it goes....when we were looking for the He 280 moulds, we stumbled on others....

In the summer, we will release the final ProfiPACK kit of the SE.5a, this time in the nightfighter version, but the most interesting item is being reserved for the fall, when we will release the new Tempest Mk.V in 1/48th at E-day. Specifically, this will be the Tempest Mk.V of the 1st production series. The second production version will



be around in time for Christmas and will make a great present, no? A Tempest Royal Class boxing can be expected through the first half of 2019, which will be a great complement to the first Mustang, a P-51D-5. This, however, is taking me out of the realm of this newsletter, but before we do sign off for this month, there are two more tidbits of information I want to divulge. The first concerns the Fokker D.VII in 1/72nd scale, which is being finalized and would like to see the first ProfiPACK kit by the end of 2018. The second concerns the Bf 109G-10 and more precisely, its Czechoslovakian development, the C-10/S-99. We will be releasing a special edition of the C-10/S-99 at E-day, 2018. I think you'll like this. Note that it will not be the admissions kit and will be a normally sold item, released for the show.

This brings us to the theme of shows. As is known, E-day this year will be held at the convention centre in Lysa nad Labem on Friday, September 28. This is a state holiday, so I apologize to those who cannot take advantage of this fact and will need to resort to taking holiday time for the show. We will not be the only such show at this venue this year. The Nymburk IPMS club will be putting on a show there in June. I recommend attending this show, and it will give some idea of what to expect from E-day a few months later. We will, of course be attending other shows as well, starting traditionally with Prosek, then at Mosonmagyaróvár, in June at the aforementioned Nymburk show, and in August we'll be flying to the IPMS Nationals in Phoenix, Arizona. Then, it's off to Plzeň, then E-day, and then Telford and Bratislava to round out the year. There will be no Brno this year; it is being replaced by the show at Lysa (the Nymburk show) and there is also no Novemberfest. The latter is going the every-other-year route like Brno.

The New Year will see an increase in the release of BFC items. There will be stand alone items such as publications from our Limited Edition releases (temporarily for EU countries only; at the end of January for non-EU countries as well) and WET TRANSFER decals. These are made by HGW, who makes them for our kits and thanks to an agreement between us and Mr. Bobek (the HGW owner) will be also offered as BFC items. There will be other items, and we are preparing special offers from the kit lines, which will be sold with expanded decal options and bonus items exclusively offered to the BFC crowd. The first such offering will

be the January release of the Bf 109G-14, which will include a marking from JG 5 and a resin wheels. The price will be the same as a standard line kit release. This idea will continue past that, and each month we will choose one standard kit to dress up in a similar fashion to be offered to the club. Getting back to the publications, three have been so far offered: HIND - Mi-24 in Czech and Czechoslovak Service, MF- MiG-21MF in Czechoslovak and Czech Air Force Service, and The Five Hundred - the Avia B.534. All BFC offers are limited and apply while supplies last.

We should have a quick look at new releases for January. I decided not to describe all the new items and their details starting this month, and only point out the more interesting of the releases. This would, without a doubt, include the ProfiPACK Bf 109G-14 in 1/48th scale, another in the line of our Bf 109Gs. For those of you that would consider this version somewhat boring, take a closer look and pay close atten-

tion to the marking options. You'll find that none are boring at all. In fact, you'll see that they are very interesting in terms of not only the striking quality of them, but for their technical details as well. These are the things that made these later versions variable and very interesting indeed. Then, you can take part in the discussions that will centre around weather or not this or that machine had a yellow rudder or underside of the cowling, or a yellow V under the wing, or whether the fuselage band was yellow, green, blue, or, God forbid, pink, whether the tail was wooden or metal, or even if the plane in question was even a G-14. It will not be boring. You can also express an opinion about the boxart. This will generate its own level of non-boring discussions from

those that have decided that they detest our style of boxart from the very bottom of their hearts to those that swear by them. As you will probably guess, we belong to the latter grouping. We choose these works of art because we feel that they are consistent with the concept around which our kits are designed. Incidentally, the G-14 artwork depicts an actual event. Hartmann's aircraft is typically the first choice for this type. I confess that this aircraft is as interesting in the offered option as it was later, when the plane was no longer Hartmann's.

The photoetched releases for the month that deserve mention include the sets for the P-51D-5 from Revell in 1/32nd scale, among others for the reason that these have the glazed instrument dials. The same goes for the Brassin set for the F4U-1D from Tamiya in the same scale. I would also like to draw your attention to the Brassin doors for the Spitfire Mk.VIII and IX in 1/48th for our Eduard kit. This set is interesting in that it is being produced by popular demand and it

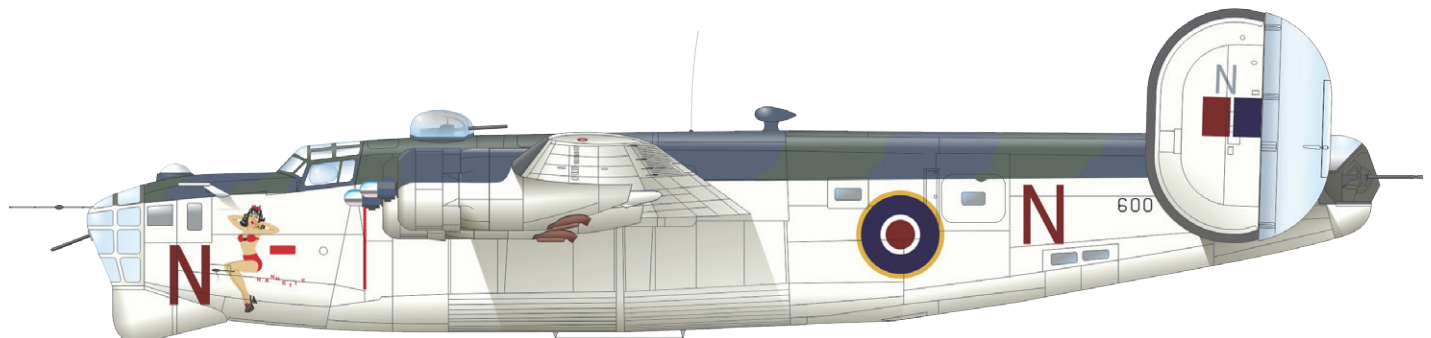


*Bf 109G-14 1/48 ProfiPACK.*

includes two doors, one with and one without a crowbar. The doors are naturally also good for the Mk.XVI. The mask sets are led by the P-51D set for the Revell kit and is the first of the TFace sets produced. Another interesting item among the mask sets is the one for the B-17G anti-glare panels for the 1/48 sale Monogram (currently from Revell) kit, depicting aircraft built at Vega.

And that is all for me now. Thank you all for your support over the past year, and we will work hard to continue to deserve it going forward. Happy modelling!

## C1149, Capt. D. W. Grinnell-Milne, No.56 Squadron, Bethencourt, France, January 1919

British fighter ace Duncan William Grinnell-Milne was born on August 6th, 1896, in London and at the age of thirteen he joined the ranks of the 5th Battalion Rifle Brigade (Prince Consort's Own). After the beginning of the war, he was deemed too young for service at the Front, and was left on the island. He was subsequently assigned to the RFC and underwent pilot training. On September 29th, 1915, he received orders that assigned him to No.16 Squadron, RFC. As a member of this unit, he took part in the fighting, but on December 1st, 1916 he was shot down and taken prisoner. He managed to escape in April 1918 and return to the British side of the Front. After that, he was assigned to No.56 Squadron, equipped with the SE.5a. On December 17th, 1918, he was assigned CO of this unit. He had the fuselage of his SE.5a painted red and named it 'Schweinhund' as a reference to his time in German captivity.
